

What is MSQC?

Your hospital is a member of the Michigan Surgical Quality Collaborative (MSQC). MSQC is a statewide group of surgeons and hospital staff working together to improve the safety and quality of general, vascular and gynecologic surgeries in Michigan.

We host several meetings a year to share data and identify areas for improvement. Each member site has a surgeon leader and a data abstractor as part of a team organized for quality improvement.

- 70 participating hospitals in Michigan
- 2,000+ participating surgeons
- 30% decrease in surgical site infections (2008-15)
- 11% decrease in urinary tract infections (2014-15)
- 13% decrease in length of hospital stay (2008-15)

Patient Reported Outcomes Surveys

As part of the MSQC program, we will track your recovery over time to see how you are doing. Only you can tell us how much better you feel or how your activity has changed since your surgery.

You will be asked a set of questions one to three months after your surgery. An additional follow-up survey may be sent to your email address in the future to track your progress.

MSQC surgeons and nurses use this information to track your progress and ensure that we are providing the best care possible to improve surgical care and recovery in the state of Michigan.
