- New toolkit items:
 - New pre-op clinic tool to assess risk for difficult catheterization, urinary retention, or catheter injury
 - Tools tailored for same day surgery and emergency department settings
 - New algorithm for voiding trials in patients who required ISC or Foley
 - Strategies for applying the tools across the continuum of care for all patients (e.g., emergency department, same day surgery, medical patients)
- > New process and outcomes measures
- Strategies provided to assess and improve prior tool implementation. Note, these strategies will also be applicable to help you reduce other healthcare-associated complications.
