Intraoperative Management of Frail Patient Checklist

- Use of previously discussed anesthetic technique
- o Consider regional blocks and anesthetics if appropriate
- o PONV risk stratification and prevention strategies
- Appropriate positioning/padding to avoid pressure ulcers and nerve damage
- Monitoring core temperature if surgery is >30 minutes
- o Use of warming blankets/warm IV fluids if needed to prevent hypothermia
- o Appropriate use of IV fluids intraoperatively
- Monitoring and management of hemodynamic markers per patient condition and procedure
- o Continuation of indicated cardiac medications
- o Avoid use of intermediate and long-acting neuromuscular blocking agents when possible
- o If neuromuscular blockade is needed ensure full recovery prior to extubating
