

## 2020 MSQC P4P and Volume Modification Due to Covid 19 Pandemic

<b>Volume/ FTE payment</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● 3/10 – Coronavirus declared a State of Emergency in Michigan</li> <li>● 3/21 – Executive Order allowing only essential surgeries</li> <li>● All non-essential medical procedures were allowed to begin again on 5/28/2020</li> <li>● There will be <b>three vacation cycles</b> available for each site for the remainder of the year, regardless of which Covid-19 situation the hospital was in. Vacation cycles do <b>not</b> need to be used for time off during the pandemic.</li> <li>● Admin cycles will be used as normal, when needed, for the rest of the year.</li> </ul>	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Any volume collected in Cycles 1 - 19 (1/1 - 5/31 OR dates) will be exempted from the volume calculation.</li> <li>● The site's average per cycle volume from 27 cycles (20-46) will be applied to the 19 excluded cycles for purposes of calculating volume/FTE payment for BCBSM.</li> <li>● You can choose to abstract cases from cycles 1-19 for baseline QI data if you have time, but this will not contribute to additional volume.</li> </ul> <p>Example #1:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. volume is 594 cases from cycle 20-46 →22 cases average per cycle (594/27cycles)</li> <li>2. 22 cases x 19 excluded cycles=418 cases</li> <li>3. Total 2020 volume=594+418=1,012 cases (1.09 FTE)</li> </ol> <p>Example #2:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. volume is 500 cases from cycle 20-46 →18.5 cases average per cycle (500/27 cycles)</li> <li>2. 18.5 cases x 19 excluded cycles=351.5 cases</li> <li>3. Total 2020 volume = 500+351.5=851.5 cases (0.92 FTE)</li> </ol>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Any volume collected in Cycles 10 - 19 (3/13 - 5/31 OR dates) will be exempted from the volume calculation.</li> <li>● The site's average per cycle volume from 36 cycles (1-9 and 20-46) will be applied to the 10 excluded cycles for purposes of calculating volume/FTE payment for BCBSM.</li> <li>● You can choose to abstract cases from cycles 10-19 for baseline QI data if you have time, but this will not contribute to additional volume.</li> </ul> <p>Example #1:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. volume is 792 cases from cycles 1-9 and 20-46 →22 cases average per cycle (792/36 cycles)</li> <li>2. 22 cases x 10 excluded cycles=220 cases</li> <li>3. Total 2020 volume=792+220=1,012 cases (1.09 FTE)</li> </ol> <p>Example #2:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. volume is 500 cases from cycles 1-9 and 20-46 →13.9 cases average per cycle (500/36 cycles)</li> <li>2. 13.9 cases x 10 excluded cycles=139 cases</li> <li>3. Total 2020 volume=500+139=639 cases (0.69 FTE)</li> </ol>
<b>Follow-Up</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Requirement for SCQRs to attempt to make 3 attempts to contact the patient in order to count as follow-up complete is unchanged</li> </ul>	

<p><b>Participation</b></p>	<p><b>P4P Measures 1 &amp; 2—Collaborative Meeting participation for the SC and SCQR:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The SCQRs will have a virtual training day on 6/19, and the SCs will have a presentation by Dr. Varghese on 6/25. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ Participation in these events will replace the points offered for the March meeting that was cancelled.</li> <li>◦ Both of these presentations will be recorded.</li> <li>◦ Completion of the CME evaluation will be your proof of attendance, and will result in the award of Performance Index points.</li> <li>◦ Deadline for completing this process is <b>July 31, 2020</b> to receive points.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Scheduled meetings on 10/2 and 12/4 will be held, but have not confirmed whether they will be held virtually or in person, virtual format is most likely at this time.</li> </ul> <p><b>P4P Measures 3 &amp; 4— Conference Call participation for the SC and SCQR:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No changes. The conference calls will be held as previously scheduled.</li> </ul> <p><b>P4P Measure 5—Accuracy &amp; Completeness of Data:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No change for IRRs previously scheduled. <p><b>QII</b></p> <p>See updated <a href="#">QI Implementation Goals-Measure 6 &amp; 7</a> for more details</p>	<p><b>P4P Measure 6—Collaborative-Wide Measure:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No change to scoring, the measurement period will include all completed cases from 1/1/20 – 12/31/20.</li> <li>• As of 5/22/20 the collaborative is at 66%, well above the goal for full-points.</li> </ul> <p><b>P4P Measure 7—Quality Improvement Initiative:</b></p> <p>The measurement period and scoring timeframe changes are detailed below:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Goal #1- Discharge Prescription with M-OPEN recommendations: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ Measurement period changed to 7/1/20 – 12/31/20 (completed cases)</li> <li>◦ 10 points for each of the 2 selected procedure groups (Maximum points: 20)</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Goal #2- Teaching and Multimodal: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ Measurement period changed to 7/1/20 – 12/31/20 (completed cases),</li> <li>◦ 5 points for each of the four metrics for the two selected procedure groups (Maximum points: 40)</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Goal #3- Surgical Site Pain Score: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ Measurement period unchanged 4/1/20 – 12/31/20 (Maximum points: 20)</li> <li>◦ Clarified Goal: Maintain or increase the proportion of patients reporting mild (0-3) pain scores compared to baseline time period (4/1/2019-12/31/2019)</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Goal #4- All Procedures Discharge Prescription: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ Measurement period 1/1/20 – 12/31/20 (Maximum points: 10)</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Goal #5- Project Report: (Maximum points: 10): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ Begin or continue tracking the work you are doing using the <a href="#">Tracking Sheet</a>. This was updated with the new measurement periods and will need to be submitted with the education materials and order sets/practice model <b>by 3/15/2021</b>.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
