

## Measure 6 - Collaborative Wide Measure

- **Population:** ALL patients who are discharged to home or to home with home health care.
- **Goal:** Increase the response rate to PROs survey collected at 30 days post-surgery by at least 50% over the 2019 baseline rate. Response rate is defined as having a complete answer from the patient to four questions. In 2019, we collected an answer to all four questions in 24.42% of the cases → to meet the 2020 GOAL we must collect the four answers in 36.63%
- **What to do:** Collect answers for the four questions below for patients discharged to home or to home with home health care.
  1. Satisfaction with Care (Pain Tab)
  2. Quality of Life (Pain Tab)
  3. Surgical Site Pain Score in the last week (Pain Tab)
  4. Do you know how many doses were taken since surgery? If YES- How many doses of opioid medication were taken since surgery? (Opioid Use Tab)

## Measure 7 - 2020 QI Implementation Goals

**Choose 2 procedures from the following: minor hernia repair, cholecystectomy, colectomy, and/or hysterectomy** (included CPTs available on [website](#))  
**Goals 1, 2 & 3 required for the 2 selected procedures**

<b>Goal 1: 90% of patients receive discharge prescription at or below M-OPEN recommendation (20 pts)</b> (10 pts for each selected procedure) M* = 7/1/2020 – 12/31/2020

Open	15 pills
Lap/Robotic	10 pills
<i>Hysterectomy</i>	
Open	20 pills
Lap/robotic/vaginal	15 pills
<i>Hernia Repair (minor)</i>	10 pills
<i>Lap cholecystectomy</i>	10 pills

<b>Goal 2: Meet 80% compliance of performance metrics (40 pts)</b> (5 pts for each metric and each selected procedure) M* = 7/1/2020 – 12/31/2020	
Metric	Variables (ERP Tab)
Preadmission pain management teaching (elective cases only)	Preadmission Counseling/Teaching → Pain Management selected
Pre/intraop USE multimodal pain management (all surgical priority)	Intraoperative use of multimodal pain management → YES selected
Postop ORDER multimodal pain management (all surgical priority)	Postoperative order of multimodal pain management → YES selected
Postop pain management teaching (all surgical priority)	Postop Teaching → Pain Management selected

<b>Goal 3: Maintain or improve surgical site pain scores (20 pts)</b> M* = 4/1/2020 – 12/31/2020
