

MSQC/ASPIRE Collaborative Meeting April 23,2021

Target Audience:

The March MSQC/ASPIRE Collaborative meeting brings clinicians together from across the perioperative continuum of surgical care to hear presentations from speakers on a variety of topics that will address multimodal pain management and patient teaching into patient care. We will host a panel discussion on acute care surgery that will include the perspectives of an anesthesiologist and multiple surgeons. A national expert will speak to the audience about transitioning from the use of opioids to the use of multimodal pain management.

- Identify and implement best practices for pain-care pathways including the use of multimodal anesthesia
- Recognize opportunities at their home hospital for improving carbon emissions in the operating room
- Participants will recognize and implement opportunities at their own hospital for improving multimodal pain management
