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<p><b>2023 MSQC Program Updates</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• New tabs, variables decrease, retire vascular &amp; add breast cases</li> <li>• New tabs will correspond with the new QI projects as well as tabs for breast and thyroid specific variables</li> <li>• Numerous variables are retiring in 2023 along with decreasing questions on the PRO</li> <li>• New CPT codes for abstraction will go live on 1/1/2023</li> <li>• Data Definitions Committee– click this <a href="#">link</a> to sign up – need SCQRs and SCs <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Also available in the newsletter or ask Cheryl if you or your SC is interested</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<p><b>MSQC QI Updates</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 2022 Mid-year scorecards <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Tomorrow (8/12/2023) is the last day for appeals of attendance on the midyear scorecard</li> <li>○ A policy is being drafted regarding attendance at meetings and calls</li> <li>○ Participants are responsible for having their attendance logged by notifying the coordinating center of phone numbers used in Zoom calls and ensuring they are checked in at in person meetings</li> </ul> </li> <li>• 2023 QI Project plans <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Details are still being worked out but proposals are due to BCBS on 9/12/2023</li> <li>○ Proposed projects will be presented at September meeting</li> <li>○ CWM will be decreasing the percentage of elective surgery on patients without disseminated cancer who smoke</li> <li>○ The usual 50 points for the QI project will be divided up into two sub-projects <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ First will consist of a project to improve an outcome measure at your institution <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Coordinating center is running data on outcomes and will present a “menu” of options based on areas of opportunities for improvement</li> </ul> </li> <li>▪ Second will be a chosen pilot project, three to pick from</li> </ul> </li> </ul> </li> </ul>

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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• SUCCESS project to limit injury from urinary catheterization</li> <li>• MPrOVE project which is a joint venture with MVC looking at decreasing the routine testing done on patients undergoing low risk procedures which include lumpectomy, lap choley and inguinal hernias             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Hospitals have been given reports by MVC with their current testing numbers. Contact will be arranged with this person at their hospital</li> <li>○ Protocols, either national, regional or specific to the hospital would be implemented aimed at decreasing the number of tests performed</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Frailty screening project which looks at identify frail patients who are at risk for increased complications following surgery</li> <li>• MOQC projects will continue with opportunity for oversampling hyst cases</li> <li>• CRC &amp; Hysterectomy reports             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Now up and running correctly.
